PRAY FOR OCTOBER 1 HOPE @ THE AMP

Opportunities for praying in community:



A prayer walk has been scheduled for Sunday, August 27, 9:21AM at The Amp. When you arrive at The Amp on the day of the prayer walk, you will be given a handout with information about the prayer walk and a scripture for reflection as you pray. The prayer walk will be kept very simple. Once you receive your handout, you will walk the perimeter of the Amp on your own praying for the service: the speakers, musicians, those who will be in attendance, and for who God is asking you to invite. You may pray silently or out loud, whatever is most comfortable for you. The prayer walk will last about 20 minutes. We will end by gathering at the stage for a closing prayer.



The Prayer Team is forming prayer groups for the purpose of praying for HOPE @ the Amp. These will be small groups of about 6-8 people per group who will commit to meeting together once a week for prayer. Each group will decide where they wish to gather to pray. Group leaders and participants are needed. Please pray about how you will be involved.



Who was Jesus, really? Wasn't the central figure to the Christian faith a man who denied all preconceived notions about what God should look like? Wouldn't associating with him have meant joining a rebel movement? Doesn't it still? Renegade Gospel is a church study that challenges believers to come to terms with the real Jesus—the rebel Jesus.

"Renegade Gospel" is a six-week study by Mike Slaughter, lead pastor of Ginghamsburg United Methodist Church in Tipp City, Ohio. You do not have to purchase a book to participate in the study.

WESLEY FELLOWSHIP SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS IS HOSTING A SIX-WEEK BIBLE STUDY ON MOSES

It doesn't get much more dramatic: rescued baby, life in the courts of Pharaoh, parting the Red Sea, leading his people out of Egypt...Moses' life was one challenge after the next, but although he resisted God's calling, by the end of his life he successfully fulfilled the role he was given.

"Moses: in the footsteps of the Reluctant Prophet" is a six-week study by Adam Hamilton, senior pastor of The United Methodist Church of the Resurrection in Leewood, TX. We will join Hamilton through his video sessions as he travels from Egypt to Mt. Sinai, the Nile, the Red Sea, and the wilderness exploring the sites of Moses' life. As Hamilton shares historical information, archaeological data, and biblical text, you'll gain a better understanding of Moses' significance in your life today, and discover how you, too, can turn your own reluctance into boldness. A book is not required to attend the study.


